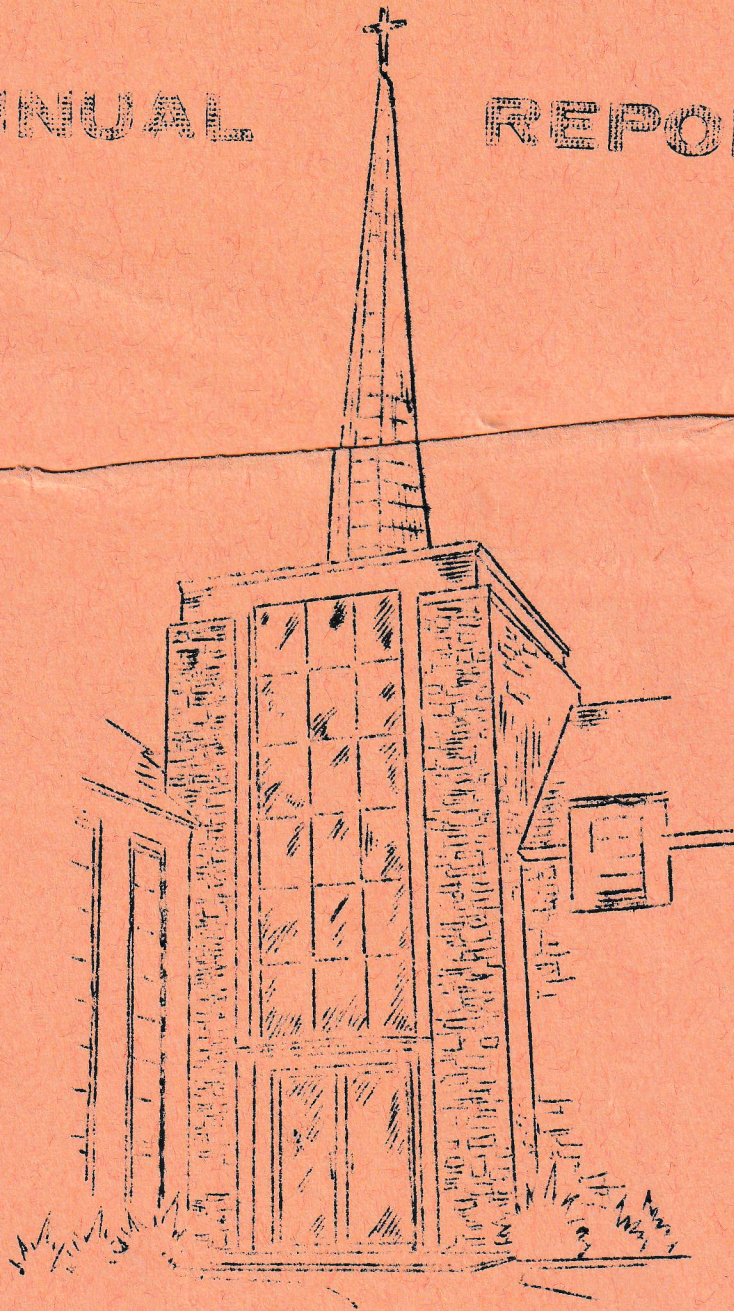

Pastor's Report

I Thessalonians 1:2,3 "We give thanks to God always for you all, constantly mentioning you in our prayers, remembering before our God and Father your work of faith and labor of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ."

Dear Members of Emmaus:

"Grace be unto you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ."

Nineteen Hundred Fifty Seven was indeed a significant year in the story of the Lutheran Church in America. Meaningful events such as Lutheran World Federation and progress in organizational mergers of synods were outstanding. Emphasis in the direction of Evangelism and Stewardship were also exercised.

While making this observation concerning the church at large, we would like to encourage every member of our local church to become truly interested in the broad program of Christ's Kingdom and the welfare of his own congregation. We realize that this interest must come through being well informed and we hope that this report of 1957 may supply a picture of circumstances in our congregation and offer inspiration through its recommendations for the future.

Let us remember that every member of a congregation shares in the responsibility for the growth and Christian development of his church. Prayer and faith and work are the fiber out of which our church is woven. We praise God for the privilege of being a part of His great interest during the past year.

During this past year we have seen the situation within our congregation stabilized into a pattern of progress for which we give glory to God. Our church's newness in appearance continues to offer us a thrill and a sense of pride to pastor and people. Its utility has proven a very real factor in effective Christian work in our continually growing community.

To all who have surrounded your pastor and his family with continued prayer and fellowship in the work of God's Kingdom, we express a very sincere personal thanks. The numerous gestures of kindness and expressions of appreciation have been a real encouragement. We are, because of earnest co-operation, inspired to look forward to undertaking the challenge God proposes for the future.

Again this year, an increasing number of hearts and hands have helped to do the tasks of our congregation. Naming all the individuals who have unselfishly given of their time and effort would be impossible and by them regarded unnecessary. There are those who have served on the church council and on committees, the Sunday School and Daily Vacation Bible School teachers, the organists, the choir directors and members of the choirs, the youth counselors, the helpers doing the clerical work of bookkeeping, stenographic work and the mailing details and those who have assisted in the maintenance and cleaning of the church property. All these efforts and others were afforded by persons who have found joy in loving the

Lord's work. The work of our congregation has again this year been accomplished without compensation to those who offer their services, except in the cases of the pastor, senior choir director and the janitor. However, recognition has been given to the need for secretarial help for the pastor and allowance has been made for this assistance in the 1958 budget.

Our attendance at worship services has increased very encouragingly since March 3, when we began to provide double services each Sunday at 8:30 a.m. and 10:45 a.m. Our average Sunday attendance for the year was 322 compared to 267 in 1956. With more fervent interest expressed in continual evangelism, we are certain that this record will be greatly improved in the year to come.

Among the special events we observed were the Second Anniversary of our new church's dedication and the dedication of the Tower Chimes system in memory of Emma Keykal on October 20. Pastor Paul Johnson, missionary to Japan, was our guest speaker on this occasion. Another guest from the mission field was Pastor Ezra who spoke to our Daily Vacation Bible School and to a joint meeting with sister congregations. It was a wonderful experience to hear the benediction pronounced in our church by the voice of one whose soul had been reached by the Gospel through our mission in Africa. In June our congregation received many guests during the Synodical Convention held in Our Savior's Church. At the Convention Services held in our church on Sunday morning, Chaplain Gilbert Jensen and Pastor Edward Hansen were the speakers. At the Women's Missionary Society Rally held in our church last spring, Pastor W. E. Wicklund, former missionary to India, was the speaker. Others who have shared in Sunday services are: Student Daniel Hansen, Pastor Edward Andersen, Pastor E. R. Andersen, Pastor George Demant and former Pastor Sigurd Petersen.

Our communion record total, 2220 communions served at twelve Holy Communion services and to 112 individuals. This record is an increase of 300 over last year. However, we are still grieved to know that so many confirmed members of our congregation persist openly indifferent to share God's strength giving sacrament of spiritual blessing.

Our mid-week Lenten Services were shared under the theme, "The Son of Man Must Be Lifted Up", John 3:14. The attendance was good, but it is obvious that special effort must be asserted to encourage attendance at all special services. No mid-week Advent Services were held, but an Adult Membership Class met each Wednesday during this season. We would like to challenge the congregation to sponsor a special Bible Study on Wednesday Evening during Advent in 1958. Beginning in the fall, the Luther League sponsored a series of Sunday Evening Services for the whole congregation and the Choir took its turn by planning a song fest for the whole congregation. These events met with a degree of encouraging success.

We remember respectfully these dear ones and thank God for the living hope He has given us in Jesus, our Savior.

New members received into our congregation - 229 souls including 116 adults (24 under 16 years confirmed included.) Our financial secretary's report will show the current number of confirmed members to be 707. We have issued letters of transfer to 7 adults and 8 children.

Our Cradle Roll reflects a considerable increase from previous years (33 in 1955) (105 in 1956) (125 in 1957). A good work has been carried on by an increased staff of Cradle Roll workers and a very successful fellowship was sponsored November 24, with a large number of parents present and the fathers participated in the program.

Our Sunday School work has begun to take a most encouraging outlook. We are not only thinking of our enrollment which is now 285 pupils, 21 teachers and an Adult Class of 25 regularly attending, making a total of 331. Our average attendance for the year was 168 with recent weeks exceeding 200 children regularly. Total Sunday School offerings were over \$1400.00. A greater emphasis has been placed on our teacher's monthly meetings and a board of education has been appointed to expedite the administration details.

Our Daily Vacation Bible School was attended by 163 with our average being 136. This was a little less than the previous year and is in part due to the use of a date one week earlier than usual. We prefer the last two weeks in August for our school and concentrated review for confirmation. A very helpful group of volunteers assisted in offering instructions, as well as nursery and secretarial duties. All materials for D.V.B.S. was obtained through registration envelopes and some voluntary gifts. The children were also inspired to make their offering to mission through the visit of Pastor Ezra.

In the work of our Luther League we have seen a momentary surge of interest and activity. We are grateful for volunteer counselors and their wonderful help in working among our youth. As we said last year and now say it again, the work among our youth is certainly related to the encouragement they receive in their homes. The Luther League's assistance in sponsoring special Sunday Evening service's has already been mentioned.

Our most recently organized element in the interest of the church is the Junior Luther League. They show wonderful promise and will surely benefit greatly in their spiritual lives by the studies shared in a course "Adventures With Christ".

Among the women of the church we still have a number of small and active groups called Guilds. Quarterly meetings were held for the entire group, to inspire their sense of unity. A new group,

the Altar Guild, has been formed and begun to serve very effectively in its purpose. Financial reports for the Guilds indicate a very active concern for projects of the church and missions. Their total disbursements nearly reach the \$700.00 mark with a combined balance of about \$300.00, some of which is earmarked for selected projects in the coming year.

The organizations of the W.M.S., with 44 members and Ladies Aid, with 45 members, also serve as a part of the women of the church. The former meeting in the evening has shared a series of very interesting programs on the theme: "Personalities In The Story Of Missions". A number of men in our congregation participated. At the Ladies Aid which meets in the afternoon, the programs were very worthwhile and well presented from a series "The Singing Hearts" prepared through the women's organization of our synod. The financial reports of these organizations are found later in this report.

Through the past year the Men of Emmaus have shared a variety of programs including interesting travel and sports films. A Father and Son Banquet was served by the ladies in April with Pastor LeRoy Andersen of Pewaukee bringing the devotional message and Principal LeRoy Ludeman, of Washington Park High, as our banquet speaker. The men have attempted several Supper-Hour meetings. Pastor L. M. Andersen and the late Congressman Lawrence Smith were among the guest speakers. A number of men have participated in the Lutheran Men in America of Racine, of which one of our members, Mr. Al Beck, is serving as president. Pastor E. R. Andersen and Pastor Thorvald Hansen are serving as advisors. In the activity of our Synodical Brotherhood our congregation has also been represented. Mr. Ernest Petersen is the present treasurer and Pastor Hansen is a pastoral advisor.

The projects launched for the year include funds for Sunday School equipment and purchase of more tables for the fellowship hall. The church picnic, Christmas fellowship and the ushering at church service's have been a part of the Men of Emmaus activities also.

Our choirs have rendered faithful service and shared a healthy spirit of leadership. For a time the Senior Choir sang at the late service and the Junior Chorus at the early. Since the beginning of the fall season the schedule was reversed. One of the interesting events sponsored by the Senior Choir was the Sunday Evening Song Fest previously mentioned. With the gradual but sound development of our choirs we continue to look forward toward improvement in the music enjoyed by our congregation. Faithfulness of our organist, who has been carrying on a labor of love by supplying her services at both early and late Worship Hours, is also greatly appreciated.

During the coming months it is urgent that we give sincere consideration to stressing a program which will study and solve our weakness in the areas of stewardship and evangelism. It is also our desire to improve attendance at Worship Services and Holy Communion.

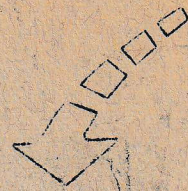

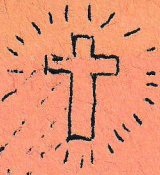
