## Vaccination Clinics

A pop-up vaccination clinic was held in the field at Emaus on Sunday, September 12<sup>th</sup>. 29 individuals were vaccinated that day. A repeat clinic will be held on **October 3<sup>rd</sup>** so that second doses will be available. People over 65 years of







age who have had the two-dose Pfizer vaccine may be able to get a booster that day. Bring your vaccine card showing proof of having received the first two doses.







## Video Streaming at Emaus

Emaus has been videoing nearly all Sunday morning services which can be found at [EmausELCA1.org](https://EmausELCA1.org). The Greater Milwaukee Synod of the ELCA and the Siebert Lutheran Foundation have recognized this technology as the "wave of the future" and has given Emaus \$2,500 to support the purchase and installation of the

cameras and other equipment. The vendor, Metro Sound and Video, will be installing the equipment on November 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>. This equipment will be the easiest to use and will offer expandability in the future. The cost of about \$8,000 is obviously outside our current budget. Accounting for the \$2,500 from the synod, we will need to find the additional \$5,500.
