May 7 Fiesta Mexicana Emaus ELCA Raffle For Refugees

May 7th the Fiesta Mexicana of Emaus ELCA will take place from 10:00 AM until 3:00 PM.

We invite you to participate by joining us for food, music, and raffles. All-you-caneat Mexican food will be served in Fellowship Hall. It will also be available for takeout. Cost of the meal tickets is \$10 for adults and \$5 for children 10 and younger.

There will be two raffles that will take place in the sanctuary on May 7th. You are invited to donate an item for the Refugee Support Raffle. Items for this raffle will include a handmade quilt made by our Emaus quilters, original artwork by children and local artists, and items donated by local businesses and other donors. The items in the Refugee Support Raffle will go to the highest bidder. 100% of the proceeds will go to aid refugees. 50% will be designated ELCA disaster Relief Fund-Ukraine refugees. 50% of the refugee support will be sent to AMMPARO, which aids the refugees at our southern border.

An additional raffle with baskets of a variety of donated goods will be to benefit Emaus and our outreach ministries. Raffle tickets for these baskets will be \$2 each. Winners of all raffles will be announced between 3:00 and 3:30 pm on Saturday, May 7.

EASY Highlights: Congratulations to the kids! Their campaign EASY for Ukraine raised \$756. Pennies, nickels, dimes and quarters do add up! We have had many discussions about what is happening in Ukraine. They understand that many children have had to travel miles and miles to safety. They have expressed how they would feel if they had to pack their belongings in only a backpack and a bag. They have talked about what they would need in the way of food and clothing. Some have wondered if they were able to bring toys and games. They have seen pictures and videos of the refugees. One video showed trucks that traveled

through many countries bringing teddy bears to the kids. They witnessed tears of sadness turning to smiles of joy.

Hands on science activities: Challenge - how many pencils can you put through a plastic bag filled part way with water without the water leaking? Lots of laughter and concentration - some were successful! With the cheers and encouragement of the entire class, one was able to place over 40 pencils through his bag.



With spring in the air (and some snow), the kids planted daffodil bulbs in pots. They are beginning to show some green shoots. All were able to witness the daffodils blooming along the fence by the back door.

We celebrated National Poetry
Month. All read and listened to



many different kinds of poems. One very windy day the kids were challenged to learn and recite the famous poem "Who Has Seen the Wind? And this prompted a discussion about the importance of trees.

Earth Day 2022 was highlighted. All received a book How To Make a Better World: Each of us can make a difference!

If you are aware of someone experiencing health issues or difficult times, you might ask if they would like to be added to the prayer chain as a part of our ministry and outreach. Some of our prayer persons are those with ongoing situations while others are very short term. If your request is for long term prayer, it is helpful to have occasional updates.
