#### How Sweet the Sound!

Did you know that the beloved hymn "Amazing Grace" is 250 years old this year? In its long history, it has become an immensely popular hymn, translated into more than 50 languages, performed about 10 million times annually, and recorded professionally over 3,000 times!

#### A little history...

The hymn was written by the English poet and Anglican clergyman John Newton to accompany a sermon he preached on New Year's Day, 1773.

He wrote the words of "Amazing Grace" from his own personal experience. He was once a man far from faith who was brought near to God by a harrowing event in his life. In 1748, while Newton served as a sea captain of a ship in the Atlantic slave trade, a violent storm off the coast of Ireland struck his vessel so severely that he called out to God for mercy. This moment marked Newton's turn toward God, what he called "the hour I first believed." Eventually leaving sailing behind, Newton then began studying Christian theology and was ordained in the Church of England in 1764.

Why do I share all this with you? As a rather roundabout way to invite you to worship in the upcoming season of Lent!

Newton recognized in himself a prodigal son, distant from God. As his hymn reveals, he discovered that God in Christ's deep and abiding love does not give up on anyone.

Our Lenten series for 2023 will tie the words of the beloved hymn to our lives today as Christ's disciples. Those in the Bible who experienced the amazing grace of God help us each week to realize that though we once were lost in sin, we now have been found by Jesus, and though we once were blind to God's mercy, we now can see his love at work in us through our Savior's death and resurrection.

Join us as we proclaim the divine mercy of our God in the crucified Jesus Christ and consider our own personal stories of "Amazing Grace!"
