

Treasurer's Report

There has been some interest in including a treasurer's report in the Visitor. The chart below shows the budget that the congregation voted for in January in the column labeled "Budget". The column labeled "Cum. Budget" shows the amount of the budget through May that we expected to "use up." The column labeled "Actual" shows the actual amounts that we took in and spent through May.

There are a couple of comments that I want to make regarding these numbers. First, these numbers represent what it takes to "run the church". It does not include our programming (e.g., EASY and education). Second, we recognized that this was a deficit budget when we voted for it in January. So far through May we have accumulated less of a deficit than we planned for. I feel that is good news.
