Mexican Children's Refuge

Emaus members, Glen and Barb Staton have been active participants in a Mexican Children's Refuge ministry near their winter home in Llano Grande RV Park, Mercedes, TX. In Mexico, education is free up to 6th grade after which many families cannot afford to pay the fees for middle school through university. Mexican Children's Refuge is located in a small tourist town on the border called Nuevo Progresso.

Several of the Winter Texans in Llano Grande RV Park sponsor children to provide an opportunity to continue their education as well as to develop a relationship with the students. For several years, Glen and Barb were the coordinators of the ministry and were crowned king and queen at a Tourist Appreciation celebration in 2017. They continue their support but have retired as coordinators. Last fall the Emaus Stitchers sent several quilts with the Statons which were distributed among the children. Following is a letter acknowledging the donation.

Hello from both of us. It's that time of year again for Invoice mailings for your sponsorships in the Mexican Children's Refuge We, and the students greatly appreciate the generosity of all our sponsors that help the Mexican children receive an education.

This past December we handed out Christmas gift bags, clothing, and other articles to several families in need at Mabel's Free Clinic close to two hundred kids and parents showed up. We also had a Clown come in to entertain the children, and they really enjoyed him.

We were also able to hand out some handcrafted blankets (made by some ladies from Barb Staton's home church this past year as well. A special thank you to Barb.

Another activity has been building an addition to a home in the Nebraska Colonia to aide in teaching students and providing meals and Church service once a week indoors due to inclement weather Last year with your donations we were able to build an addition to a home for a family who took in the children of their relatives that had passed away due to Covid as well.

In February we had the Mabel's Celebration at the Secondary school. Scholarships were also out in February; we gave out 160 scholarships, with several of the students receiving an extra \$10.00 for getting perfect or near perfect grades.

We have created a Facebook group where you can view pictures and videos that we participate in. The group to look for is Mexican Children's Refuge. There is another group that is using a name similar to ours, so please be aware when searching.

We will be heading back to the Valley within the next few months to hand out scholarships so please watch for our postings on Facebook. As always, we would not be able to continue this work without your support and we thank you again.
